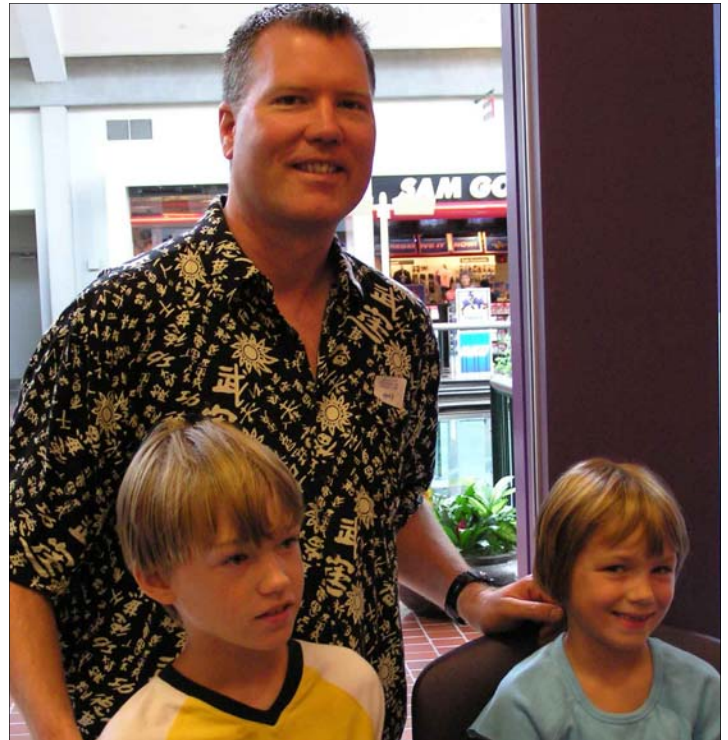

- Dec. 31 . . "New Year's Eve Party"

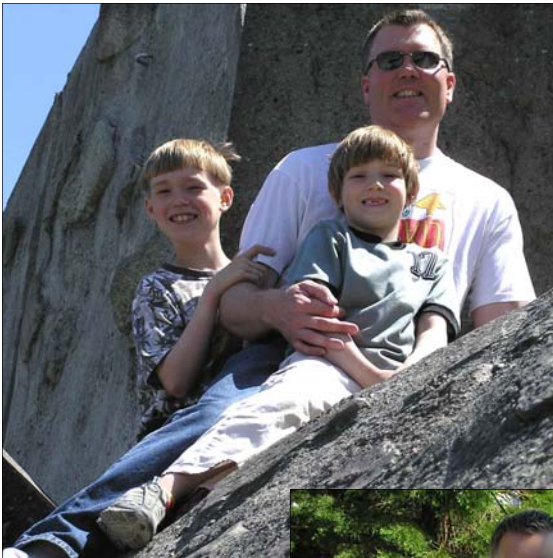

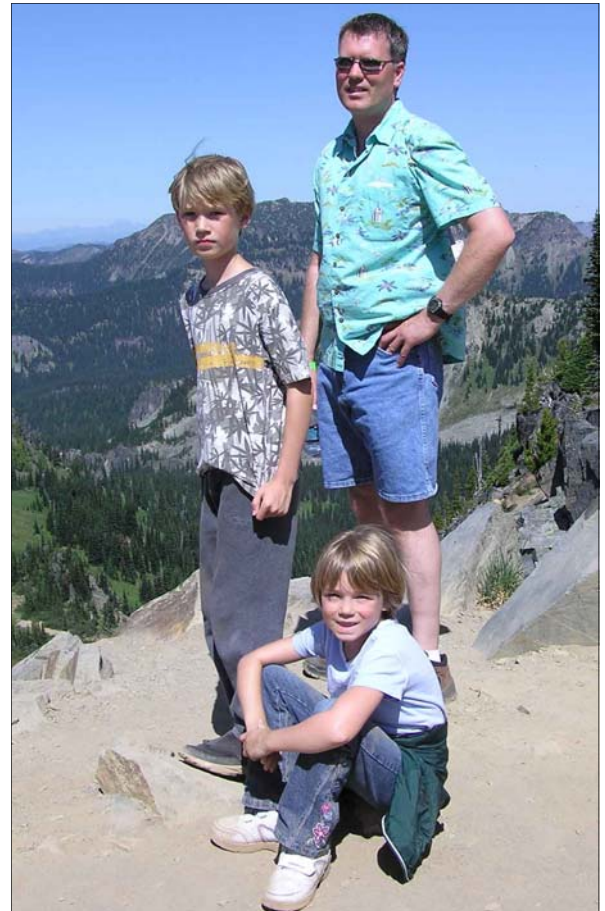
